Using Eye Medications

Eye Drops

- 1. Wash your hands
- 2. Shake the bottle of drops to mix medication.
- 3. Tilt your head back and look upward. IF you have difficulty accurately getting the drop in your eye you can use the bridge of your nose as a resting point for the bottle. This will allow you to efficiently target the corner of your eye without waste.
- 4. Use care to make sure that you <u>DO NOT</u> touch the tip of the bottle to your eye, lashes, and lids.
- 5. After placing the drop in your eye, close your eye or press your finger to the corner of your eye toward the nose (see below) for 1-2 minutes to retain the medication in the eye and allow adequate absorption.
- 6. If you are using <u>more than one type of drop</u> and are dosing them at the same time, make sure you wait at least 5 minutes between each drop. This prevents washing one medication out of the eye with the other.
- 7. Make sure to store the drop with the lid on tightly between doses.

Eye Ointment

- 1. Wash your hands
- 2. Squeeze a ¼ inch strip of ointment onto your index finger (about the size of a piece of rice)
- 3. Pull down on the lower eye lid creating a pouch.
- 4. Using a rolling motion with the tip of your finger, place the piece of ointment into the eyelid pouch.
- 5. Close your eye and roll your eye around under the lid. This will spread the ointment on the surface of the eye. Your vision will usually be blurry for a while as ointment is thick and coats the surface of the eye.
- 6. Make sure you store the ointment tube with the lid on tight between doses.

If you have difficulty knowing when you have properly instilled a drop in the eye, you may refrigerate the medication. This will allow you to more easily feel the drop when it makes contact with the eye.
