

Blogger DMCA bulk submission XML schema

1. Elements Description

dmcaTakedownRequests	Top-level element that contains all of the information for a given bulk submission, made up of one or more <code>dmcaTakedownRequest</code> . For example, a bulk submission reporting ten infringing URLs would have ten separate <code>dmcaTakedownRequest</code> elements.
dmcaTakedownRequest	Contains all of the information for a given infringing URL.
service	Describes the product where infringing content is hosted. This will always be <i>Blogger</i> .
permalink	The specific location of the infringing content, which must be in the form of a blog post URL. Blogger post URLs are always in the format of <i>homepage/year/month/title.html</i> , ex: http://buzz.blogger.com/2011/03/whats-new-with-blogger.html
contents	Parent element containing information about the various infringing content within a single blog, organized by specific infringing works.
screenshotLink	Link to screenshot of infringing transient content
isTransient	Is the infringing content streaming/transient [TRUE/FALSE]
content	Contains the description of a specific piece of infringing content within a single blog post. A blog post with links to three separate illegal downloads would then have three separate <code>content</code> elements.
copyrightLocation	The infringing URL that appears in the post identified by the permalink, if the takedown concerns a link that appears in the post, e.g. http://rapidshare.com/files/432423/charlies_angels.rar
copyrightOwner	The owner of the copyright, e.g. Sony Music Entertainment
copyrightWork	The title of the content being infringed, ex: 'Lady Gaga + Born This Way'

DTD Requirements:

1. The `dmcaTakedownRequests` has one or more `dmcaTakedownRequest` elements.
2. The `dmcaTakedownRequest` has three sub elements - `service`, `permalink`, `contents`.
3. The `contents` element should have one or more `content` elements.
4. Each `content` has three fields (one require and two encouraged).
 - a. `copyrightLocation` (encouraged)
 - b. `copyrightOwner` (encouraged).
 - c. `copyrightWork` (required).
 - d. `isTransient` (required)
 - e. `screenshotLink` (required if `isTransient=TRUE`)
